All Heritage® Series shingles offer a Better-Than-"Lifetime" Limited Warranty.

Some manufacturers may promise a "lifetime" limited warranty. But the simple truth is, it's not the length of the limited warranty that matters. It's the length of the Full Start period (the up-front coverage value that includes both material replacement and labor costs) that makes the difference.
